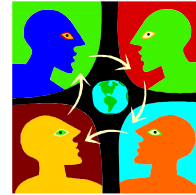

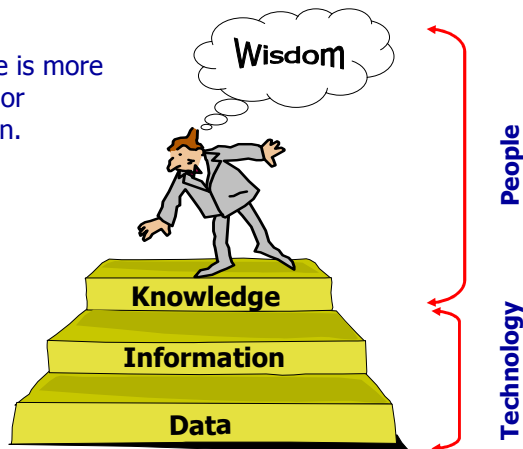

You're outside Washington driving to the airport to catch a plane to New York for a meeting:

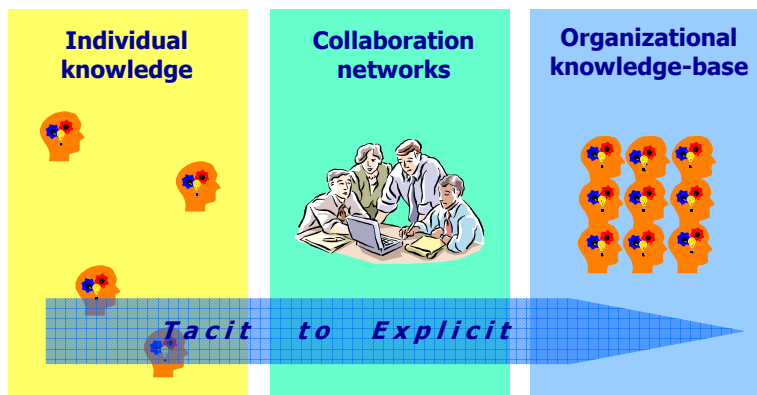
- ▶ **Data:** 10, 34, 25.
- ▶ **Information:** A weather station 10 miles from Dulles Airport reports sleet, temperature 34 degrees, wind out of the west at 25 mph.
- ▶ **Knowledge:** You know the weather will cause delays or cancellations and you may miss your meeting.
- ▶ **Wisdom:** You reserve a seat on the next Acela train so you get to your meeting on time.

- Humans possess knowledge and wisdom.

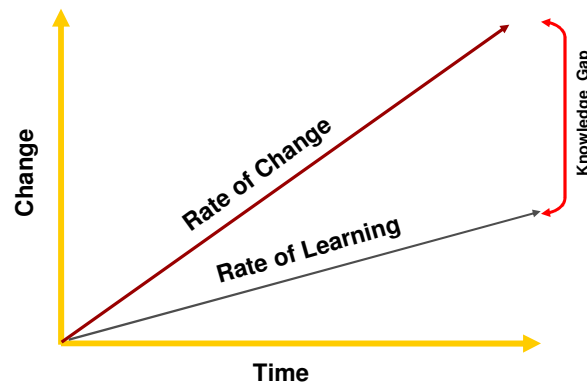
