What is Knowledge

- **Data**: Documented observations / opinions
 - Natural observations- No control
 - Experimental observations - More control
 - Experts' opinion – Full control
- **Information**
 - What is the data telling us – Interpretation
- **Knowledge**
 - Concepts tested and agreed upon

Libraries –

Access points to organized data / information


- **Classic** Libraries: *Literature*
 - Books, periodicals, standards, patents
- **Non-Classic** Libraries
 - *Materials* Reference Libraries
 - Strategic Highway Research Program
 - *Data* Libraries
 - Many National Projects required research databases
 - State DOTs management systems
 - Highways, Traffic, Bridges



Research and Learning

- **Research** objectives: three steps
 - **Learn** what has *already been done*
 - Literature review
 - **Define** what is *really missing*
 - Problem statement
 - **Create** what is *not known*
 - Research Work plan
- **Learning** objectives:
 - **Knowing** what is documented to:
 - Develop opinions
 - Make decisions
 - **Implement** knowledge
- Without libraries the process is difficult, perhaps not possible
