






Case study: NASA JPL

Benefits: Integration of multiple data silos and taxonomies for precision access across more content





New Science: Understand new scientific results that expand knowledge of environmental links to health.

Phthalate linked to preterm birth. A study from Italy finds that not only are DEHP and MEHP detectable in most Italian newborns, but that those with higher levels of MEHP are more likely to be born prematurely. This result suggests that at least some of the scientific effort to understand why the incidence of premature birth in the US has increased 23% since the early 1980's should focus on environmental contaminants in the womb, and specifically on phthalates. More...

Testicular cancer linked to environmental exposures early in life. Finnish men who immigrate to Sweden are much less likely to develop testicular cancer than Swedish men, no matter how old they were when they emigrated from Finland nor how long they lived in Sweden. These findings implicate exposures in the womb as important determinants of testicular cancer, and are consistent with an emerging theory about the causes of a pattern



Seamark / Geospatial Visualization Integration

- Use Seamark's "pinpoint navigation" to quickly narrow search results
- Search selection (e.g. latitude, longitude, and other relevant metadata) is passed via Seamark "syndication" into 3rd party analysis tool (e.g. ArcInfo, GoogleMaps, Oracle Map Viewer, etc.)
- Split screen UI combining faceted navigation and 2-D / 3D visualization.




Seamark selection: "earthquakes in August 2005 of any magnitude" and associated textual metadata output to GoogleMaps




Three steps to a Seamark application














Conclusion
